3. funeral expense.

Enrolment process

All students must apply to take a course at Aspiring Language Institute using the school's official Application form. The application form needs to be signed by the student to acknowledge that they have read, understood and accepted the condition of enrolment.

Student under 18 years of age at the time of enrolment, MUST have their application form signed by a parent or legal guardian. Please note that enrolment process may take some time; we recommend starting the process at least a month in advanced.

Once we accepted the application form, we will issue an Offer of Place along with a invoice with our bank details.

We do not accept students that are overstaying in the country or with an overall attendance below 90% from their previous course

Student fees must be received before its commencement date; note that we will not make any homestay arrangement without receiving fees

When agent receives the student fees, they have the obligation to comply with NZQA's Student **Fee Protection Rules 2013**

Once fees are received the school will issue a **Confirmation of Payment (receipt)**; to be used for the student visa application

Refund and cancellation policy

Eligibility

A. Before the course commencement date:

Students who cancel their course before its commencement date will be refunded the tuition fee in full. The application fee and accommodation administration fee will not be refunded.

If the school has already organised insurance for the student, the insurance fee is also not refundable.

B. After the course commencement date:

- For courses not longer than five weeks, 50% of the tuition fees can be refunded to a student cancelling his or her course no later than two (2) days after the course starts. Tuition fees cannot be refunded after this date. The cancellation notice must be in writing.
- For courses longer than five weeks but not longer than twelve weeks, 75% tuition fees can be refunded to a student cancelling his or her course no later than five (5) days after the course starts. Tuition fees cannot be refunded after this date. The cancellation notice must be in writing.
- For courses longer than twelve weeks, full less a deduction for cost incurred by the school minus a maximum of 25% of the fee total paid can be refunded to a student cancelling his or her course within the first ten (10) working days of their course. Tuition fees cannot be refunded after this date. The cancellation notice must be in writing.
- If, for the some reason, the school has to cancel the course before the commencement date, we will refund in full the fees paid. If the course is cancelled after its commencement date, we will refund pro rata for the weeks not delivered.
- Where payment is received from an overseas study agency, we will pay tuition refund to that agency. Any such agency is considered to be the student's representative, retailing our school services.
- Transfer of tuition entitlements between students is specifically prohibited.
- Refunds or enrolment extensions will not be given to students:
 - taking a holiday during their course, unless approved by the Institute
 - arriving later than the course start date, unless approved by the Institute
 - leaving the Institute before the course is finished, unless approved by the Institute
- Students enrolled for 6 months or more may have up to 2 subsequent weeks holiday during the the dates of holiday agreed on at the time of enrolment. Changes to these dates can be Institute's discretion. If the planned holidays are not taken, the course will be shortened accordingly.
- If, for some reason, students are not able to obtain their visa, we will refund pro rata for the weeks from the date the student inform the school their visa was declined.
- Homestay dates are from Saturday to Saturday, or Sunday to Sunday. If you are staying longer than specified above, please contact us to arrange the additional payment. Homestay fees will be refunded if you move to a private accommodation, if you give us at least two weeks' notice about the move.
- The Institute will not be held responsible for any sickness, damage, injury or loss incurred at the Institute, at the accommodation organised by the Institute, or at any activity or trip organised by the Institute. It is the student's responsibility to have adequate insurance to cover medical expenses, repatriation and loss of school fees if the student needs to shorten the enrolment (or cancel the course) as a result of any such event described above.
- The Institute reserves the right to amend fees and conditions at any time.

Process

- All Withdrawal /Cancellation requests must be made in writing to the school and signed, dated by the student (or parent for under 18 years old) and presented with supporting documents, such as a letter from Immigration New Zealand or Medical Certificate, giving reasons.
- All refunds will be made to the student's account if the withdrawal request is approved and the student is entitled to any refunds.
- Written permission will be requested if the student wishes any refund to be paid to a third party. In this case, the school needs to obtain the third party's identification as well. Whether the refund to the third party is accepted or not will be decided by the school's fee protection provider (Public Trust) and the school has no power over their decision.

Homestay refund and cancellation policy

- 8(+) Days prior to commencement of the homestay, we will retain the placement fee and we will not refund the balance of homestay fees paid
- 7(-) Days prior to commencement of the homestay, we will retain the placement fee and 1 week's homestay fee, and agrees to refund the balance of Homestay fees paid

3. Attendance Policy

It is the New Zealand Governments requirement that all foreign students who enrol at a school or university in New Zealand must attend 100% of their classes.

Students who are frequently absent from school will receive a series of warnings.

Absence of five days over one month or less than 85% attendance rate is sufficient to issue the first warning to the student. Up to three warnings can be issued. The third is considered to be the final one, after this, if your attendance does not improve, your enrolment will be terminated and referred to Immigration New Zealand and their visa or permit may be revoked. School fees will not be refunded.

Certificate of Attendance will only be given to students with an overall attendance rate of 80% or above

4. Disciplinary rule

Aspiring Language Institute reserves the right to expel any student who breaks the New Zealand law or the school guide rules, including persistent unexplained absence. We will not refund fees in the case of expulsion and we will notify the Immigration New Zealand.

5. Code of Practice

ELIGIBILITY FOR HEALTH SERVICES

MEDICAL AND TRAVEL INSURANCE

International students (including group students) must have appropriate and current medical and travel insurance while in New Zealand.

IELTS and NZCEL entry requirements

IELTS preparation course

- Must achieve over Intermediate level on Aspiring's placement grammar test
- Must pass an Interview test
- Must be able to complete writing test with a satisfactory result
- Is planning to take an IELTS test

Alternatively, if your level is lower than the required to join the course, you will start in the General English course.

Please note that If you have taken the IELTS test and have achieved an overall band of 5.0, you will be exempt from the grammar and writing tests; however, the test result must be no older than 1 year (12 months)

New Zealand Certificate in English Language (NZCEL), Level 4

Be over 16 years of age, and an overall Academic IELTS of 5.5 with no band lower than 5.0, or equivalent
